We just returned from Morelia, Michoacán, Mexico, from a week of camp with 249 in all, including camp staff. Mike that we did not know before. The Lord has been the mainstay for the family and his co-laborers throughout this time.

It is hard to believe that it has already been over months since his promotion, but it definitely makes one wonder what it is truly like in Heaven. The Lord has not given us much information about Heaven, but we cannot even begin to imagine what it must be like. Oh glorious day!

How grateful we are for the good health that the Lord has given us throughout our 43 years of full-time ministry. Certainly, there have been occasions of sickness, but when we hear of others in ministry with their health problems, oh my, we cannot but kneel in humble prayer to thank our great God for His goodness to us. He is truly amazing. Next month Bacilio will hit the great 70 mark. He told that to someone just the other day, and the man could not believe he was that age and in such good health.

We thank you all for your faithful support throughout the years. It has been the way the Lord has used to keep us on the firing line. We are not yet thinking about hanging up our cleats. We still have some races to run and victories to win, by God's grace.
