Praise the Lord for the many opportunities God has opened for us to minister His Word and connect with people. During these last several weeks we were enabled to participate in mission conferences and meetings in Michigan, Pennsylvania, and Tennessee. It was a great blessing to reconnect with our supporting churches. Thank the Lord for these pastors who have served at their churches so faithfully for so many years!

With the Hispanic ministries Allen has been preaching through the book of Ephesians at Iglesia Bautista Tabernaculo Wednesday nights. During the month of April, Allen conducted a stewardship conference for four Sundays at Iglesia Bautista Nuevo Amanecer. Many commented how these Biblical principles challenged them to order their finances and lives to be more effective stewards of God's resources.



For several weeks, our home church at Tabernaculo had been preparing a special Easter choir with the children and teens to present the Gospel at the local flea market. The church was not granted access, however, and just two days before the planned event God gave Allen grace with the manager of a large grocery store to get permission to present at that store. Incredibly enough, this was the same place, where three months before, Allen and another brother were prohibited from handling out gospel tracts! Amazing what God can do!



May is Nelido's last month of his internship with us at the church. It has been a blessing to work with him and mentor him in church ministry. Pray for his future, whether the Lord would have him return to his home country of Bolivia or some other place of ministry.

Allen has maintained regular weekly contact with Roberto Diaz to coordinate his coming on board as a church-planting missionary with MGMI and with his paperwork to obtain the religious visa. This is our first candidate to partner with in obtaining legal status as a church

planter and to work alongside during this transition into the US. Lord willing, Roberto will be a model for others who will come on board in the future. The church in Georgia that he helped start is moving forward and waiting for his return once his legal requirements are met. Pray that God gives us wisdom with these choice servants of our Savior. Our mission director and Pastor Fernandez thank you for partnering with us so we can partner with these church planters and together multiply our efforts to impact our world with the wonderful saving grace of God!
