Graduation day at Puerto Rico Baptist College was a great day, in spite of having only one graduate. Josue Coca was an excellent student with a great servant’s heart to go out and serve our Lord. But think of it this way, we have already accepted two new students with three more pending waiting government permission to be able to come as foreign students. We have an additional 10-12 students desiring to attend this next school year. At the present there are no funds to help those additional students who are desirous to attend. We have already used reserved funds so as to be caught up on the bills. We truly need you to help us to give the “go ahead to those additional students. \*\*

The field is already white for the harvest, as Jesus Himself said, but those willing to help in the harvest are so few. As John 6:28 says, “What shall we do, that we might work the works of God?” We must do

what we can while there is still time to prepare laborers for that ripe harvest. A half scholarship per student is \$2,400.00, for the year.

It is always a very busy time, as such necessary things must be done for the coming school year, and prayer must accompany every new year. Only our God can do it all and supply for all the heavy financial and physical needs.
