Dear Praying Friends,

On September 15<sup>th</sup> we hosted our annual Día del Taco (Taco Day) at Grace Baptist Church. Our families cooked authentic tacos and other food representing their homelands. The English church was invited to come eat to raise money for missionary projects. This year over \$1500 was donated toward the future construction of Sunday school rooms at the Iglesia Bautista Jesus Salva (the church Jacinto pastored for 11 years in Mexico). Jacinto has a burden to take a team to Mexico to make this project a reality next year. Please pray for God's leading and provision for this project.

Many of our members enjoyed a special family retreat at Living Water Christian Camp in Candor, North Carolina, on September 27-29. The weather was unseasonably warm—so much so that we ended up cancelling our traditional bonfire! We heard great preaching by Stephen Villareal, a West Coast Baptist College graduate with plans to serve as a missionary in Jalisco, Mexico. We enjoyed a great time of games and fellowship, and many important decisions were made during the weekend.

A few weeks ago, we had a very special Sunday at the Iglesia Bautista de Gracia. Three families who have been attending our church for several months joined by letter. Four families were recognized for completing a ten-week discipleship study with Jacinto. Pray for two of the families that they would take the step of obedience to be baptized.

We have had a need for some time for a new couple to work on our Hispanic bus route. After recently completing the three-year Bible Institute (Seminario Bautista Panamericano) video course, Agustin and Ana González came to Jacinto and expressed how they felt burdened to begin serving on the route. Agustin and Ana began attending our church many years ago after their two boys rode the bus to our Vacation Bible school one summer. Since they began visiting the route, we have seen an increase in the number of children attending services. Pray that they would reach many children and their parents with the gospel.

Jacinto had the joy of leading a 19-year-old woman, Isabel, to the Lord on door to door visitation in a trailer park.

Pray that she would grow in Christ and become a faithful church member.

Since our "baby" went off to college at the end of August, we are still getting used to how quiet the house can be and how long the food lasts! Julie is a senior, Joey a sophomore and Jimmy a freshman at Bob Jones University. Joshua is back in Greenville working and waiting on the Lord to show him where He wants him to serve. Johnny and Hephzi are also living and working in Greenville. Jason is working in construction, and Judy is teaching first grade and battling with several health issues. Jacinto is getting several minor health concerns attended to at this time. We appreciate so much all your prayers for our family!
