Dear Friends and Family,

God is doing great things, not just in Mexico, but in molding me into a vessel fit for His use. One month ago, I had an accident while playing soccer at a camp, and I broke my foot. God has been teaching me a lot of things, including patience (I still need to walk on crutches for another month) and humility, as there are many things I cannot do without help. God has been giving me the strength I need and times of rest. For instance, this past week was cultural week at the elementary school (they always have a special week leading up to their holiday Day of the Child on April 30), and they had a lot of activities and fewer classes, so I didn't have to teach as much, which was a nice break for me and my foot.

Even with a broken foot, I thankfully am still able to teach and go about my normal routine (except with a few changes, like not going upstairs to my room as often, and using two chairs to teach: one for me to sit in and one for my foot). I was still able to attend the annual Bible conference the week after the incident and serve in the orchestra, playing the piano for a couple special music numbers, and singing in a group for a couple more specials. The messages were a great challenge and blessing. Please pray for the faculty, students, church members and visitors who attended, to remember what we learned that week and be faithful to decisions made.

On Resurrection Sunday we had a sunrise service on a hill, with a regular Sunday service to follow. It was a great time of remembering Christ's sacrifice and the power of the resurrection.

Classes go on as normal, aside from the recent special activities at the elementary school. I pray that my English students would someday be able to use what they learn for God's glory, whether it's being a missionary in an English-speaking country, or just remembering a couple Bible verses in English with their meaning, and being able to share them with someone who speaks the language. I pray that my music students would use what they learn to serve God by playing for His glory, and by serving in a local church's music ministry.
