This summer God permitted me to do a little bit of deputation to raise some more support. This was actually my first time doing deputation, as God has provided each year through donations and help from my family and a few others. My favorite part was getting to visit other churches of like faith and practice and getting to meet more of my family in Christ. There was no church able to support me monthly at this time, but each church where I presented my ministry gave an offering, and, therefore, God proved His faithfulness to provide once again.

I returned to Hermosillo on Monday, August 12. The first week there were teachers' meetings for teachers of Ebenezer Bible Institute and Seminary, and the following week I started teaching English at the Christian high school again. The week after that, classes at the Christian junior high school started on August 26. I am teaching English to three grades in junior high (7th-9th grades), and to two grades in high school (10th and 11th). I am also teaching a music/choir class in junior high, as well as teaching private piano and voice lessons.

Thank you for your prayers for me so far this semester. I am enjoying my work teaching young people and aspiring musicians. I am busy but not overwhelmed. God also provides times of rest, like today, for example. Classes have been canceled in the junior high and high school because of heavy rain. They treat a day of rain here in the desert like they treat a day of snow in the southern United States: everything closes down. It does make sense, though, because there are a lot of dirt roads here, the dirt turns to mud, and driving becomes dangerous. There are also a lot of paved roads, but they often get flooded when it rains because of inadequate drainage systems. But I'm not going to complain about a little extra free time. ☺
