God has been so good to me these past couple of months. Let me start off my letter by sharing a few of His blessings. I had a great time at home with my family in July and August and enjoyed serving at my church in Illinois. In mid-August, shortly before coming back to Mexico, I was able to go to Greenville, South Carolina, where I spent a short time with my sister and her husband, as well as a lot of friends. I also briefly got to present my ministry in the Hispanic service at the church where I attended and helped out for about five years while at BJU. It was good to see everyone. They were very kind, and several of them gave to my ministry this school year. I am thankful for them, for my church in Illinois, and for all of the rest of you who support me financially and/or in your prayers. During the time that I was a short-term missionary, God confirmed His call for me to serve him here long-term. Please pray that the Lord would raise up the necessary long-term support. This year, as in the last two years, I am teaching English, piano, and voice, as well as helping out with the music and children's ministries at church. This year, however, I am now serving at a different church, which is pastored by fellow missionary Ron Cochran. I am so thankful that God is already using me there in various ways, playing the piano on Sunday mornings at a mission of the church, playing the violin in the church orchestra in the evening services (when I am not playing the piano), helping with children's choir, and sometimes playing the piano for adult choir practice. One blessing of this church in contrast to the previous one is that there are several pianists sharing the responsibility to play for services. Also, it is right across the street from IPES, and the other church was nearly an hour away by bus. It makes a big difference not to have to travel so far.

One more blessing, which is also a prayer request, is that God has led me to enter into a relationship with a young man who also has a heart for serving God in Mexico. Please pray for God's grace, for wisdom, and for us to keep our hearts pure and to keep Christ at the center of our relationship. We still have a long way to go in getting to know each other, and he has a few years left to study (he is an older IPES student).
