Dear Friends,

Thank you for continuing to pray for me this semester. I am grateful for the various opportunities God has given me to serve: English classes each morning during weekdays, piano and voice lessons in the afternoons, my violin lessons, playing the piano Sundays and Wednesdays, door to door evangelism and discipleship on Saturdays, teaching Sunday school to 3-5 year olds, and participating in the Bible institute events and ministering musically whenever I can. God has been teaching me how to be busy and yet get the rest I need. He knows exactly how much each of His servants can handle.

God has also been teaching me other lessons. In March, my debit card was stolen and a large amount of money was taken out of it. The card has since been cancelled, but I didn't have a way of getting money out of the bank. Even so, God has showed me time after time how He is faithful to provide (the new card was mailed to my house in Illinois far away). I can now also say what Paul said, "I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: everywhere and in all things, I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me" (Philippians 4:12-13). Not too long ago, I called the bank, whom I had told about the transactions that were not from me, and they had done an investigation and returned all the money! God is good, all the time!

As I continue to teach these final weeks, I realize how much God wants me to learn. Sometimes it feels like I am learning more than I am teaching just from the practical life lessons that God sends my way.

Please pray for **strength** to finish this semester well. Please also pray for **guidance** for next year. I would like to return to Hermosillo as a long-term missionary. I would also like to ask prayer for certain **contacts** made in evangelism. One lady, Lupita, seems to be born again because she is very interested in spiritual things, but she is often discouraged from going to church because most of her family is unsaved. Another, Maricela, also saved, has not been going to church recently because she feels depressed and doesn't feel like leaving the house. (She has diabetes and lost a leg a couple years ago because of it.) Please pray that God would continue doing a work in them, encourage them, and that they would learn what it means to obey God, which includes assembling with other believers as just one of the many things that God wants from us. Finally, pray for God's name to be exalted in Hermosillo and all of Mexico.
