It's been a busy semester, but it's been a blessing seeing the ways that God has used me, not because of who I am, but because of His grace. I have enjoyed teaching junior high and high school this past year, as well as giving voice and piano lessons. These semesters there were so many students who signed up for voice lessons that I was only able to have two piano students.
