Dear Praying Collaborators in ministry for our Lord,

In July we had still had a deficit for the purchase and installation of the second generator for PRBC (Puerto Rico Baptist College). By faith, we authorized the administrator to make the installation date appointment. In the matter of a week, the Lord touched the heart of a pastor in Hampton, GA, and our church donated the remaining \$1,700.00. It took a while to get it installed, the first one having already been installed. Last week was the first real test of both generators, as the electricity was out for the better part of three days. Thankfully, with the help of many of our brothers and sisters in Christ from around the world, everything worked wonderfully. Thank you to those of you who gave, prayed and trusted in the Lord for His hand of provision.

We recently finished up 2 weeks of youth camps in Atecuaro, Michoacan, Mexico. The first week of camp, the Lord blessed with a good number of salvation decisions, others surrendering for full-time service, and numerous others who got their hearts right with the Lord. Eunice had the privilege of speaking to and encouraging several girls and one mother with more personal situations. We are very thankful that some of the hard things we have been through, the Lord has used to help us help and comfort others. He always knows what He is doing.

The second week of camp was probably one of the hardest weeks we have had in our years in camp. Such a heavy spirit was so apparent. Not that the young people were bad, but the apathy and lack of spiritual desire was felt from the first day. There were some decisions made, for which we praise our Lord's name, but the spirit was depressing to others. We are praying that the Lord will use what these precious young people heard preached and taught will be foremost in their minds and be transferred to their hearts and lives. Upon discussing the hardness of heart with the director of the camp, he reminded us that we are now not dealing with first generation Christians, and many of the young people have seen inconsistencies and hypocrisies in the lives of others, including their parents, pastors, Sunday School teachers, etc. The same apathy that we

see in many of our USA churches is happening in Mexico. Oh, may the Lord revive the hearts and churches in both of our countries and around the world for His honor and glory!

From Michoacan we went to Celaya, Guanajuato, for a week in a national conference (which always brings in many from outside of the country), where we had a fairly heavy schedule, with BA preaching in one of the services and taught 5 classes during the week. Eunice was able to have 5 different classes. They kept us busy. At that conference, there were numerous classes and preaching services, with many others participating in the preach and teaching. We know there were salvation decisions, as well as hearts gotten right with the Lord, but we did not hear any of the results, knowing that the Lord will continue working in the hearts of His own. With much prayer and supplication, the Lord helped us both, but especially Bacilio, to have the strength and stamina to be able to fulfill each of our scheduled classes and/or preaching.

From Celaya, on August 11, we went to Cuernavaca, Morelos, for the weekend to preach there all day on Sunday, where three people came to the Lord for salvation, PTL. It was such a blessing to see our Lord work for His honor and glory.

We returned home on the following day, Monday, and were able to spend a few days at home. On Thursday we left to participate in a family camp in a Hispanic camp in SLC, UT. The Lord blessed with two first time visitors to any church function, and by His grace, both came to know the Lord as their Savior. We are presently at home enjoying a few days with one of our twins, who came to visit us, for a very short time.

Bacilio's kidney function continues to be low, and he tires quickly, but the Lord continues to sustain. It is constantly gratifying to see how the Lord keeps sustaining him when the need is greatest.

We continue to have a busy schedule and would ask for your continued prayers that the Lord will continue to bless and use us. Thank you to all who have so faithfully supported us throughout these many years. May the Lord richly bless each one.
