We serve an awesome God. How He can allow such lowly, sinful human beings to minister for Him is beyond our comprehension, but, oh, how thankful we are that nothing depends on us but on Him.

This past year has been a very full one, with many new experiences and challenges. Iglesia Bautista Biblica, a Hispanic church that the Lord allowed us to begin last January, just completed its first year in existence. We have about 20 people attending with many more that have visited throughout the year as a result of our visitation program and our once-a-month booth ministry at a nearby flea market. The growth has been slow due to the work schedules of the Spanish-speaking people. They are very sought after, and they find that many are required to work on Sundays. That is an area for which we would seek your diligent prayers. Babies in Christ need to be in church for spiritual growth in their lives. It has also been very difficult to establish discipleship classes due to scheduling.

Bacilio’s health has also presented us with multiple challenges. Bacilio’s kidney failure has kept us busy with doctor and lab appointments. We have had three separate dear ones come to us and say they wanted to donate a kidney to Bacilio. The first two were not accepted, as the evaluation process revealed certain possible health situations that could make it detrimental for them to donate a kidney. The third is now beginning the evaluation process. We have never solicited a donation. These people have desired to show their love for us in that manner. It is very humbling, and we are very grateful to them. Having said that, we have left everything in our dear Lord’s hands and want to move as He sees fit. We know that He can speak the word and heal Bacilio, but we also know that healing may come after the Lord calls us Home. All is in His hands. What better place can they be?

Once possible kidney donations were suggested, we decided to check out our financial responsibilities. After talking with the transplant facility and our insurance agents, we have been told that our part of a very expensive medical procedure would come to a little over \$8,000.00. Of course, the donor would not pay any part of the procedure. To our surprise, people have already asked about sending in contributions and where they should be sent. Our dear home church people have already given a generous sacrificial
