Dear Praying Friends,

On Thursday of this past week, Bacilio began having pains and swelling. As we were in the process of looking for a different nephrologist because of the distance to the other one, we were not able to get an appointment until the first of November. His situation was not going to wait for that time, so the primary doctor told us to go to the ER at Piedmont/Fayetteville Hospital. His hemoglobin was very low. It finally came up to an acceptable level after two transfusions.

On Friday he was taken to install a catheter for dialysis. That evening he received his first dialysis treatment, on Saturday treatment number two, and today his third treatment. Thankfully, he tolerated all very well. His original pain has returned as well as a bit of swelling on his left upper arm. They are once again talking about a possible hernia, for which he had another ultrasound. We are waiting for the results of those tests. Please pray for a quick recovery.

We have an additional prayer request. Often, a different phase of life necessitates a change in ministry, not a cessation of ministry. We are praying that the Lord will reveal His direction to us as to this new stage of life. In the past, different pastors and ministries have expressed an interest in our helping out in certain aspects of their ministry. One of which is a Hispanic ministry in another state, another is to help start a Spanish ministry in an American church. Nothing, of course, will be considered without much thought and prayer. Please pray with us for the Lord's direction wherever He may decide to use us. Our desire is to continue to serve Him until He calls us home.

Thank you all for your prayers. That is the most important remedy for all of life's challenges.
