## July Newsletter: Summer travels

Dan and Opal traveled to Nevada from June 6-10 to speak at Iglesia Bautista Libertad's missions conference. The first day of the conference was on June 7, our 27<sup>th</sup> anniversary. That night after the service, the pastor and his family took us out to eat and surprised us with a special anniversary desert. As is our custom, we had previously chosen a convenient day during the month to eat out for our anniversary, but we greatly appreciated the special treatment. Dan spoke numerous times over the weekend, and Opal had the privilege of speaking to the ladies during a divided session. We enjoyed the fellowship with this dear Hispanic congregation and their pastor, and it was our blessing to have been able to challenge them to consider their area as their mission field (Nevada is one third Hispanic).

From June 24-29, our family served at Camp Chetek in Chetek, Wisconsin, as the "missionaries of the week." Each evening before Pastor David Cajiua (the main speaker) preached, Dan shared about our 17 years in Mexico, our current ministry throughout Latin America, and of ways the campers can serve as missionaries, too. Opal shared her testimony with the campers in one session. From Tuesday morning to Friday morning, we provided an illustrated challenge to the campers. In one of those illustrated devotionals, Opal helped with the illustration by teaching the campers how to make tortillas by hand!

Anna, Abby, and Daniel helped at the camp in the snack shop during the week of camp. While we were there, Randy Tanis, the director of the camp (and Opal's youth pastor when she was growing up in Watertown, Wisconsin), asked Daniel to stay for the remainder of the camp weeks this summer.
