Hidalgo, Mexico, teaching trip. From October 11-19, Dan ministered in Chapulhuacán, Hidalgo, Mexico. The plan was to make this trip a week earlier, but Hurricane Helene left our house without electricity for six days. Providentially, Dan was able to switch his tickets for the following week, at \$85 cheaper than the original cost of the tickets. Dan flew to Querétaro, Querétaro, which was a five hours' drive from his destination, but was the closest airport to Chapulhuacán. From the airport, good friend Abraham Rico drove Dan five hours up the mountain and returned a week later to drive him back to Querétaro. Dan preached in Chapulhuacán, where Pastor Benito Hernández serves as pastor. Pastor Benito is also the director of Alpha and Omega Bible College, where Dan taught Philosophy of Education to pastors who traveled in to take the course, as well as to the teachers at the Christian schools from kindergarten to college. This is the second time Dan has taught for Alpha and Omega Bible College's master's degree program; the first time was when he taught Hermeneutics in 2021.

Representing MGMI. From September 23-26, Dan represented MGMI at BJU's REACH week, a time dedicated to exposing BJU's students to missions and other outreach opportunities. Dan had the opportunity to interact with students around campus, as well as in a class where he was invited to speak. The day after BJU's REACH week, Dan was planning to represent MGMI, TEAM Mobile Seminary, and IPES at the annual National Conference on Hispanic Outreach, but Hurricane Helene hit the area that day, canceling the event. Additionally, we were going to host the thirty-year reunion of the 1994 Mexico Missions Team at our house on September 28. This is the team where Dan traveled on an eight-week trip with the BJU missions team to 13 states in Mexico. This was also the trip that God used to solidify Dan's calling to Mexico and was when Dan first visited Hermosillo. Although Hurricane Helene canceled the reunion plans, we did have a digital reunion by Zoom a couple of weeks later.

From October 28-30, Dan represented MGMI at Appalachian Bible College's missions conference. Dan was able to interact with dozens of missions-focused students during the conference. When the conference ended, Dan was able to travel to Virginia to spend a few days with his parents. Thank you for your continued prayers for Dan's Dad, as he plods through chemotherapy and immunotherapy to deal with his stage 4 colon cancer.
