Dear Friends,

We are rejoicing over outreach opportunities the Lord has given us recently. It feels so good to be “back in the saddle again” now that Covid-related restrictions have been reduced here in South Carolina.

On May 2nd we celebrated the Día del Niño at church. Children’s Day (April 30) is always a big event in Hispanic culture, and we take advantage of that to reach out to new families in our community. Though we did not have as large an attendance as we have had in previous years, we were happy to have around 80 children attend. Jacinto received a call from one mother who had received a flyer at her house and could not read Spanish. She wanted to know what the flyer was about and if her children could attend. Of course, we said yes, and she came to church for the first time with her two children. Rebecca always encourages her Spanish students to participate in this activity. Several of her students passed out flyers, and 13 students attended and helped in different activities serving popcorn, snow cones, face painting, etc.

Jacinto received a call requesting a chaplain visit at the hospital. The young man he visited, Delfino Mejia, was working on a roof when he fell off breaking his back. He recognized Jacinto because he had previously worked with our son Jason in construction. Jacinto had the joy of leading Delfino to Christ. Pray for his healing and for spiritual growth.

Several new families attended services on Mother’s Day. We enjoyed special activities honoring all the mothers in our church. During the church service, our children’s church kids sang several songs directed by Julie with Joey playing guitar accompaniment. Our men prepared a delicious banquet of carne asada, served all the mothers, and did all the clean up! We enjoyed a great time of fellowship together.

Ana Navarro shared during testimony time about going to a restaurant to eat with her family. The waitress noticed when they bowed their heads and prayed before eating and asked them if they were religious. Ana had the opportunity of giving the waitress a track and inviting her to visit our church.

We presently have three adults studying in our Bible institute video classes. Rebecca plans to restart our Ladies’ Bible study
