## News from Janine Fox

Dear Praying Friends,

God has been good to me this semester in giving me many opportunities for service, especially in the area of music. As I have mentioned in previous letters, starting this school year I have no longer been teaching English at the Christian school, but instead I am giving more private music lessons, which I have been doing each year. In addition, I am giving a music class one day a week to two groups on Tuesdays at the Christian elementary school.

At the Bible college, things are getting busier as we prepare for the events surrounding the graduation in May. There have been a lot of rehearsals for the sacred concert that they do the week of graduation, and my voice and piano students are preparing for their upcoming recital. I continue to help by playing the piano for services at church and playing the violin in the orchestra when someone else plays the piano. I even have had a couple of opportunities to substitute for the choir director during rehearsals, both for the Bible college choir and the church choir at Emmanuel Baptist Church.

On Saturday and Sunday mornings I continue to help at the mission church in Tres Reinas. Saturday Bible clubs have an attendance ranging from 12 to 30 children. Please pray that we might be able to reach their parents with the gospel and that more families will be added to the church. On Sunday mornings the same children that come on Saturdays usually come, as well as a few adults from the surrounding neighborhood. In addition, a couple of teenagers that have been faithful in past years are starting to return to the services. Please pray for the salvation and/or spiritual growth of Sol Esmeralda and her brother Chuy. Sol has recently made a profession of faith and continues to come to church. Please pray for me and for a couple of young ladies from the Bible college as we try to disciple her.

Please also pray for me, as I would like to get my visa changed to a temporary residency, which could include several benefits such as being able to open a bank account in Mexico. I need the Lord's help to be diligent in this process, as I tend to struggle to do tasks outside my routine that have no set due date or pressure to push me to do them. Please also pray for strength for me, the teachers, and the students at the Bible college and seminary, as the heat has already arrived, and it can be draining on our energy.
