Dear Prayer Supporters,

How thankful I am for the time I was able to spend with my family in late July and early August, and I'm especially grateful for God's provision of a car to take down to Mexico. One of my tasks this summer, besides being physically and spiritually refreshed, was to find a good, used car. God provided one for me at a good price, and my dad helped me take it to Mexico mid-August as I went down for the start of another school year. It is nice going to church without having to wait for a Didi (a paid ride similar to Uber). I have also been able to serve by giving rides to a few people, including my neighbor, some ministry friends, and a few girls from the Bible college.

Classes are off to a good start. Elementary and junior high classes in the Christian school (Colegio Educativo Emanuel) started on August 30, and classes in the Bible college and seminary started on August 31. At the Christian school we are continuing the online format until the school is ready for in-person classes. There are some repairs that need to be done and air conditioning that needs to be installed before we can go back. Here it is still hot in September, and it can get somewhat hot even in October, so air conditioning is essential for our small school. The Bible college and seminary (Instituto Práctico Ebenezer y Seminario or Ebenezer Bible Institute and Seminary) is continuing with in-person classes as normal.

This year the Christian high school has changed so that the students will work online in an independent format with a supervisor who will check their work, due to insufficient finances to pay teachers. As a result, I am no longer teaching English in the high school. Instead I am teaching English to fifth and sixth grades in the elementary school, Kindergarten English, and continuing to teach English and Arts (Music) in junior high as I have been doing the past three years. I will also be giving voice lessons to a few IPES students this semester and piano lessons to two children. On Saturdays I help with a Bible club close to the church plant in Tres Reinas. On Sunday mornings I go to help at Tres Reinas and play the piano for the service, and on Sunday and Wednesday evenings I go to Emanuel Baptist Church in downtown Hermosillo, where I play the piano. If there is another pianist on the schedule to play, I sometimes enjoy playing the violin in the orchestra.

- Provision for students, parents, and teachers at the Christian school
- Salvation and/or spiritual growth of Antonio and his son, also named Antonio, who have evidenced a desire to attend church. Both have made a profession of faith but do not seem to have an interest in spiritual things.
- For the possible return to in-person classes in October for the Christian school and for the health of the students and teachers
- Spiritual growth of God's church in Tres Reinas and Emanuel Baptist Church
