The teachers' meetings at Ebenezer Bible College and Seminary began on Tuesday, August 13. The following week the students began to arrive and get settled in, and classes began on Tuesday, August 24. This semester I am teaching Music Theory again, and I have a class of 12 students, most of them in their first year. Please pray for the new students as they get adjusted to college life, their schedules, and the discipline required to succeed.

God has given us many new students serving at Emanuel Baptist Church this year. Several of the new students will be assigned to help at the church plant in Tres Reinas, as well as the other two church plants started by Emanuel Baptist in Molino and Mazatán. Please pray for wisdom for the church leaders involved in the decision of which students to send to the different mission churches.

Please also continue to pray for the growth of the church in Tres Reinas. There is a mother named Lupita who recently started attending church on Sunday mornings along with her young children who have been coming to Bible club on Saturdays. There are also a few children who used to come faithfully a couple years ago and then stopped going, and they recently started going again. Please continue to pray for the salvation of Abril, a teenage girl who goes to church occasionally but seems much more interested in what this world has to offer. Also pray for a lady named Cruz Elodia, who professes to be saved and goes to church on occasion, but whenever there is a family event, she will choose to be with her family instead of going to church.

Some of you know that I had a dog named Suzy who went missing over a year ago in July. I used to pray that I would find her, but after a year went by, I had given up on finding her, praying instead that she would be well taken care of by someone who cared for dogs. Another one of my prayers had been that if I did find the person taking care of her, that it would result in an opportunity to share the gospel. I am happy to say that God answered yes to each one of those prayers. A couple weeks ago a lady from church who owns dogs shared a Facebook post with me about some dogs that were being given up for adoption, asking me if one of them was my dog, Suzy. Immediately I recognized the face in one of the

After some calls and investigation, I was able to contact the lady who was taking care of my dog, a lady named Blanca Isela who rescues dogs from the streets, takes care of them, and puts them up for adoption. The next week I bought some dog food for the lady as an expression of gratitude and was able to invite her to church. Blanca Isela came to church that Sunday and heard the Gospel. She hasn't made a salvation decision yet, but she would like to come to the ladies' meeting this Thursday. I am praising God for prayers answered, and I'm praying for this lady's salvation.

I am thankful for the continued opportunity to teach piano and voice lessons. I have 14 private music students, two of whom are learning both voice and piano, two that are just voice, and the rest are piano. Please pray that they will use their musical abilities to serve and glorify God.
