## News from Janine Fox

January, 2022 (a few days late)

Dear Prayer Supporters,

My goal was to write a prayer letter each month this year, in hopes that the increased frequency would help me to remember to write. It is not January anymore, but I am sure I am writing sooner than I would be if I did not have that goal!

God showed His sovereignty and goodness to me at the beginning of this month when I got Covid. It was a mild case, comparatively speaking, just a fever for a couple days followed by a slight cough and congestion. I lost my taste for certain things for a couple days, which made an interesting experience when I drank coffee that was peppermint mocha flavored, but I might as well have been drinking hot water that left my mouth with a cool feeling because of the mint, but my tastebuds couldn't detect it. Anyway, I was thankful to have gotten sick while at home with my parents, for a couple of reasons. First of all, my mom took good care of me; then when my fever broke, I was able to help my parents when they both got a fever. Secondly, I had to postpone my January 8 flight to a week later, which gave me extra time with my family. Some classes in Mexico were online, so I was able to work from home a little while recovering from lingering fatigue. Praise the Lord, all of us in my family who got sick have fully recovered.

I arrived safely in Hermosillo, Mexico, on Monday, January 17. This semester I am continuing to teach English to 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grades, kindergarten, and junior high, just like last semester. Music classes through the Bible college and seminary started last week on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of January. I will be teaching the same three voice students that I had last semester, as well as several new piano students. There has been a lot of interest in piano lessons this semester.

Services in the mission church in Tres Reinas have continued, although attendance has dropped somewhat recently since a lot of people are sick, whether from Covid or from the normal seasonal illnesses. Winter has always been a peak time for respiratory illness here in this dry climate. Please pray for the father of a young lady who teaches the children's class and who is suffering from a long-term chronic illness. Thank you for praying for Abril (age 12) to show fruit of salvation. We have been able to talk on the phone most nights this past week. She is making an effort to read the Bible for herself, and has told me she wanted to pray before hanging up on more than one occasion. Please continue to pray for God to do a work in her life and for her not to be drawn toward the world, which happens with so many her age.
