Dear Praying Friends,

God is always good, and I am thankful for the extra displays of His goodness and sovereignty during these unique times. As I wrote in my last update, I have been at home with my family since late March, when the pandemic was really starting to hit the United States and Mexico. Yet the distance did not impede me from continuing to minister to Mexican people, but rather God used it to stretch my technological capabilities, since I had to learn to use technology such as Zoom and Google Classroom. I am also thankful for social media such as WhatsApp that enables me to keep up with people in Mexico.

Classes finished in early June—in a normal situation the school year would have finished at the beginning of July, and I said goodbye until the fall to my students on the computer screen. One of my high school students, who will not be my student anymore because she will be in her senior year of high school (the last year of high school they are not given English classes), asked me to keep teaching her during the summer, so I have been using Zoom to have lessons with her three times a week. Also, a Mexican pastor and his wife asked me if they could practice their English with me during the summer, so I have been talking to them nearly every weekday. It has been good to have their fellowship.

I am thankful for the extended months with my family, but it also makes me miss Mexico more, because I have not been away for Mexico for this long since 2015. All schools in Hermosillo will be starting online this fall, but I would still like to go back at the end of this month, if the Lord allows, in order to serve in any way that I can, such as playing the piano for online services. Please pray for my return at the end of this month, that the flight will not be changed (a lot of flights have been changed or cancelled recently), and for health and safety.

Other prayer requests:

- For God to continue to work His will through the pandemic
- Healing for many Mexicans who are sick and protection for those exposed to the virus. Many Mexican Christian brothers and sisters have family that have contracted coronavirus.
- Wisdom and flexibility for teachers and students
- Adaptation to a different living situation this year
- Continued provision
- Praise the Lord for another church's support!
