Dear Prayer Supporters,

God has been so good to me this semester at International Baptist College and Seminary in Chandler, Arizona. Last spring, I got the sense that God wanted me to prepare myself further by studying music, specifically church music, to be a more effective music teacher in Mexico. God opened the door for me to study a second masters' degree here, specifically Master of Ministry in Church Music, with the principal instrument of voice. God has been making it clear that I am in the right place, from providing for my tuition through work and generous donors, to benefiting from the classes, to meeting people at the school and church, and being able to serve in the church, Tri-City Baptist Church, from which IBCS came about.

God has also given me opportunities to minister alongside Spanish-speaking people. My roommate, a fellow grad student, is from the Dominican Republic, and I have been able to serve in the Spanish ministry at Tri-City. I have also been able to maintain contact with some people from Hermosillo. Please continue to pray for the salvation of Blanca Isela, the Catholic lady who found and took care of my dog who was missing last year, not knowing to whom the dog belonged. Pray, too, for Abril, the young lady who has attended church so often in Tres Reinas and at the youth group at Emanuel Baptist Church but still does not exhibit a changed life with evidence of being born again.

I am thankful for my job working at the daycare called Time for Tots, a ministry of Tri-City Baptist. I am working there almost full-time with three-year-olds. Each day my coworker and I have about 10-16 kids in one room. It can be a challenge, especially since many of the children come from unsaved, unchurched families. Please pray that God will give us patience, love, and wisdom, and that He will use my coworkers and me to make an eternal difference in the lives of these young ones and their families.

I am enjoying my classes—voice lessons, Biblical Foundations of Music Ministry, and Research and Writing. Singing with the Chamber Singers and participating in Handbells is a great blessing. We recently had our Chamber Singers concert on October 27, and the theme was *We Believe*. Several of the songs had an evangelistic message, and several others were meant to encourage believers, including one with a brief solo that I got to sing. At the end, the college president Nathan Mestler gave the gospel. Several church people who attended commented afterward that God used the concert to be a blessing to them. Please pray for the salvation of two coworkers of a choir member who came to the concert.

I am hoping to visit Hermosillo during Thanksgiving break. Please pray that I might be able to bring up my car to be able to use for deputation, which would involve making sure that it is running smoothly before starting the trip, and I would like two or more people to accompany me on the trip up to Arizona.
