Dear Family and Friends,

I am thanking the Lord for His great goodness to me this summer and the beginning of this school year. This year I decided to stay in Hermosillo for the whole summer for a few reasons. One, I wanted to participate in the activities of the summer, such as Vacation Bible School. I got to help with VBS at both Emanuel Baptist Church and its mission church in Tres Reinas. I was also available to help with the piano at church at a time when many people were on vacation or out for other reasons. The heat was hard to endure, especially at the outdoor Sunday morning services in Tres Reinas, but God sent rain and/or clouds every now and then to give us a break from the heat. In the desert in Hermosillo, it rains a lot from early July through September and hardly at all the rest of the year.

School started again in late August, both at Ebenezer Bible College and Seminary and Colegio Educativo Emanuel (Emanuel Christian School). This year the junior high grades at the school have switched to an online format, just like the high school did last year, so now I am only teaching English in the preschool and elementary grades during the morning and early afternoon. I stay busy most afternoons and evenings, however, giving piano and voice lessons at the Bible college. Praise God for providing a lot of music students this year. There was also a large amount of students who came to the Bible college this year. At the Christian elementary school and preschool there are few students, and it is difficult for them to cover expenses and to pay my fellow teachers, so prayers for more students would be appreciated so that more children can receive a Christian education.

Many children are still attending the mission church in Tres Reinas, and recently a new family started attending. Please pray for spiritual growth of all who attend and for faithfulness and good health for those of us from Emanuel Baptist Church who help at the mission church.

I am especially thankful for God's provision for a new place to live, closer to church, the school, and the Bible college. This past summer I found a house for rent, a good bit bigger than the apartment where I was. I needed a bigger place for my dogs (my dog had puppies in June, and I gave all of them away except for two who stayed with me), and someone told me about this house that a Christian brother was renting. The fact that the rent was the same low price as the apartment and that the house was closer to work and church helped me to realize that this was from God. I also got to choose the paint color for the interior which needed a makeover. I am thanking God for His faithfulness and provision.

- Spiritual growth for the children, teens, and adults who attend church in Tres Reinas, especially for two teens—a girl named Abril and a boy named Brian
- Comfort and grace for the Badachi and Duran families. Juanita Duran (a faithful member of Emanuel Baptist Church) was hit by a car and went home to be with the Lord on September 11.
- Provision for the elementary and preschool at the Christian school
- Opportunities to be a spiritual influence to the children in my English class

- Wisdom and diligence for planning classes and teaching
- Grace and strength, organization, and my own spiritual growth


