Dear Prayer Supporters,

Thank you once again for your prayers and support throughout this past year. There were times when I knew people must be praying for me, such as the time when I was in contact with people who tested positive for Covid-19 but did not show a sign of sickness myself, and the time when I had a car accident, but with minimal damage to my car and no physical damage to any person involved.

This past semester God has shown His faithfulness in many ways. We were able to return to in-person classes at Emanuel Christian School in October and November for the first time since the pandemic started. Elementary and preschool students returned in October, and the junior high students in November. Their high school now has an online/in-person format with one teacher supervising, so I am no longer teaching high school English, but rather elementary (5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade combined) and preschool classes. I am continuing to teach English in junior high as before, as well as a few voice and piano private lessons. It has made a great difference being able to be with the students.

The church plant in Tres Reinas has been growing considerably. A lot of children have been coming to Bible club in the park on Saturdays, sometimes as many as 60 children, most of which also go to the church service in Tres Reinas on Sunday mornings. Several parents also attend sporadically with their children, although we are praying for more faithful families. I get to help with crowd control on Saturdays and playing piano for the church service on Sundays. It has been a blessing to be able to use my car as well to take some children to Bible club and church and back to their houses.

I was able to get permission to leave for Christmas vacation a week early to attend a wedding in Chandler, Arizona. God was good in His provision and care for getting me there, where I spent wonderful moments with Christian brothers and sisters, and for getting me to my home in Illinois to be able to spend Christmas with my family. I look forward to seeing what God will do in the next year.
