Dear Pastor and Church:

Please accept our warmest greetings from Tabernacle Baptist Church.

It is a privilege for me to be able to communicate to you that the things that have happened to us in these past two months are an encouragement and blessing to us. As I write this, I am in my office reflecting on all that, by the grace of God, has resulted in blessing and spiritual growth in our lives and ministry.

In our last letter, we let you know how blessed we are that the Lord brought a Nicaraguan family, a Cuban family, and a Dominican family to our church. We also have experienced the fact that the enemy of our souls is real and tries to defeat us in our expectations of growth in the congregation, which sometimes goes away even as it comes. But this does not discourage us from continuing to fight the good fight of faith and to continue to sow the blessed gospel in people around us.

Please join us in prayer so that families may be established in the family of faith and grow for the Lord and His work, where the man takes his place in the family, grows in Christian character and becomes the leader of his home, and where the woman takes with sobriety the important task of collaborating in the upbringing of her children in the Lord and where the children, with hearts surrendered to the Lord, are obedient and honor their parents with their lives. All of this is to bring honor and glory to the Lord of our lives. One of my greatest requests before the Lord is that families saved by the grace of our blessed Savior come to church with hearts seeking to live before the Lord, our Savior, lives of service and dedication for His work.

Currently I am discipling a brother online who gave his life to the Lord on July 24 of this year at the altar of our church and for whom we ask for your prayers. His name is Antonio Garay. I see in him a genuine thirst for the Word of our Lord, and his desire is to see his family saved and serving the Lord.

Recently I have been teaching a personal evangelism class, and my wife has been teaching music theory. We were greatly blessed by the participation of the believers who came to the service in the typical dress of their country of origin and also enjoyed delicious food of Mexican-Salvadoran-Guatemalan-Nicaraguan, American origin. Finally, I want to share with you my first evangelistic pamphlet that I made to reach those who are not yet saved. This pamphlet was inspired by a message that I preached in the church called "The Weight of a Soul." I shared with you in a

previous letter that an American church with a printing ministry helped us, and we managed to print the first 6,000 in Spanish and 1,000 in English. The brochure has been received with wonder and interest by those to whom it has been given. It is our prayer that the Lord will use it for the advancement of His work.

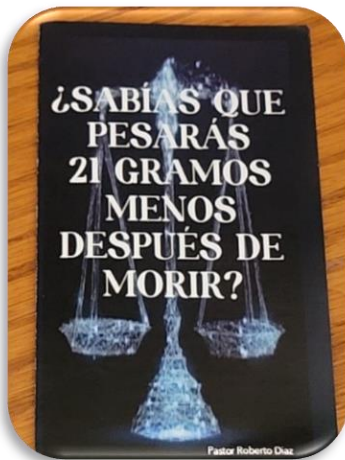
Finally, we ask for your prayers for the following needs:
