## News from Ron and Jackie Cochran

Dear Friends,

Several years ago, a friend gave us a wreath that is hanging on our front door. It has just one word on it that especially expresses our feelings during these past months: Grateful. As you may remember, in December Ron's biopsy came back positive for prostate cancer, and we began praying then as to what route to take: operation in the States or here, which procedure, which doctor, and which hospital, as well as provision to cover the costs. We are grateful that the Lord led us to have the procedure done here, answered all the other questions in our minds, and provided abundantly to cover everything. The operation was on March 6, and the Lord has given Ron a good recuperation. On April 7 Ron had bloodwork done to make sure the PSA had dropped. The doctor wanted the number to be less than 0.2, but unfortunately his came back at 2.4, so the doctor prescribed another round of medication and follow-up bloodwork, with a possibility of a PET scan if the number doesn't continue going down. We appreciate your prayers as we continue through this stage of our lives that God has prepared for us.

This month is a busy time for us, with Family Camp April 17-19 and Bible Conference April 22-25. The theme of Family Camp is *Modeling the Christian Life*, and the theme of this year's Bible Conference is *Worship that Glorifies God*. One of our graduates, Rafael Garcia, will be preaching the evangelistic services, and Dr. Peter Davis from IBCS (International Baptist College and Seminary) will be teaching several sessions per day on philosophy of Christian music and various themes that have to do with music in the church. We are looking forward to great blessings during these two weeks and are grateful for the well-prepared people who will be participating with us as we learn how to better live and worship in a way that is worthy of the Lord.

Once Bible Conference is over, we are back to normal classes on all levels. In the Bible college and seminary, we have just three weeks of classes and then finals and graduation. Please pray for our prospective graduates to finish well and for all our students as they go to serve in their home churches during the summer months.

In our last letter, we asked you to pray for our Christian school. With additional costs for new government permissions that the school doesn't have money to cover as well as a diminishing number of students, we may have to close the school; please pray for 50 students (the number we need to keep the school afloat) to enroll by June for the next school year.

We are so thankful for each of your prayers for the ministry here in Hermosillo and for us personally. We are also so grateful for the special offerings we received in these last months to cover medical costs. May the Lord richly bless and use each of you for His glory.
