Because Tap was recovering from pacemaker surgery in September, our trip to the States was postponed until just before Thanksgiving. We are thankful the Lord still made it possible.

It was a special blessing to spend Thanksgiving with 17 family members while also visiting supporting churches and several new ones to share what God is doing in Mexico and South Asia.

Our travels took us through several states and ended in South Dakota, where we spent Christmas with our oldest son Tap and his family. Along the way, Tap was able to reconnect with relatives he had not seen in more than 55 years and to meet others for the very first time. We believe the Lord gave us this opportunity to see loved ones again and to plant seeds of the Gospel.

During the trip, Tap spoke more than 40 times about the ministry in Mexico and South Asia. We are deeply grateful for the strength the Lord provided and for the blessing of making what may have been our last trip of this kind. 🙏🙏

Denise and I enjoyed the snow and cold weather during our travels—a welcome change from Mexico—but we were glad to return home as the warmer days approached.

Since June 2025, Tap had faced months of throat-clearing, coughing, and congestion. After many treatments and even a
